


THE STATS....

- 94.5% OF SOCIAL SCIENCE AND LAW GRADUATES ARE EMPLOYED 3 YEARS AFTER GRADUATING.
- 7.6% OF SOCIAL SCIENCE GRADUATES IN EMPLOYMENT WERE CLASSED AS MANAGERS AND SENIOR OFFICIALS.
- More than 70% of social science graduates were in professional or associated technical occupations, while some 7% worked in finance and insurance.


